Pursuant to Article VIII (MBE/WBE Substitutions) of the MBE and WBE Special Conditions Regarding MBE/WBE Commitment and Schedules attached to the Contract as <u>Exhibit 3</u> (the "Special Conditions"), with this letter SDI Presence LLC ("SDI") requests that the City allow SDI to modify its Schedule D Compliance Plan set forth in <u>Exhibit 3</u> of the Contract (the "Compliance Plan"). A copy of the current Compliance Plan is attached hereto as <u>Appendix A</u> for ease of reference.

SDI wishes to revise the Compliance Plan because SDI's WBE on the Contract is currently GMS Consulting, Inc. ("GMS"). Margaret Goldstein, the sole owner of GMS, informed SDI that both she and her employee staffed on the project (Tom Trybus) are retiring effective as of January 1, 2020.

SDI wishes to further revise the Compliance Plan to add a new WBE, AAR & Associates Ltd. ("AAR"), effective as of November 1, 2019. The WBE Goal for AAR will be 5% commencing on November 1, 2019. A copy of AAR's Cook County certification letter is attached hereto as <u>Appendix B</u> for ease of reference. A copy of the revised Compliance Plan and AAR's Schedule C-1 are attached hereto as <u>Appendix C</u>. Both GMS and AAR will work together commencing November 1, 2019 and continuing through January 1, 2020 to provide for a smooth transition of services between WBE vendors.

1. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

This summary of significant policies of the statement of direct labor, fringe benefits, and general overhead (the "Cost Report") of the Company is presented to assist the readers in understanding the Cost Report. The Cost Report and notes are representations of the Company's management who is responsible for their integrity and objectivity. These accounting policies conform to accounting practices presented by Part 31 of the Federal Acquisition Regulations ("FAR") and have been consistently applied in the preparation of the Cost Report.

Nature of Operations: Founded in 1999, AAR & Associates, Ltd., is a full breadth technology firm. The Company specializes in developing technology infrastructure, proprietary software management tools, and installation of hardware and life cycle management. The Company also provides consulting expertise in the area of telecommunications with emphasis on program and project management and network system engineering.

Basis of Accounting: The Cost Report has been prepared on the basis of accounting practices prescribed in Part 31 of the FAR. Accordingly, the overhead schedule is not intended to present the results of operations of the Company in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

Use of Estimates: The preparation of the Cost Report in conformity with Part 31 of the FAR requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts during the reporting period. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

Cost Accounting: The Company maintains a job-order cost accounting system for the recording and accumulation of costs incurred under its contracts. Each project is assigned a job number so that costs may be segregated and accumulated in the system.

Direct Labor: Direct labor consists of the actual cost of employee time charged directly to projects in the Company's job-order cost accounting system.

Fringe Benefits: Fringe benefits comprise the Company's costs related to payroll taxes, paid time off and health and welfare benefits.

General Overhead: General overhead consists of costs other than those related to direct labor and fringe benefits that are not directly charged to projects in the Company's job-order cost accounting system.

Property, Equipment and Depreciation: Certain assets are purchased and depreciated, while others are leased and considered operating leases. The annual lease costs are included in the overhead pool. The depreciation costs included in the overhead pool which are reflected on the Company's financial statements are in conformity with Generally Accepted Accounting Principles and is allowable under FAR 31.205-11(e).

Subsequent Events: Management has evaluated subsequent events through October 24, 2019, the date the report was available to be issued.
