#### Explain :

In connection with its EZ Pass Service Center Contracts with the New York State Thruway Authority/Canal Corporation, the Triborough Bridge and Tunnel Authority, and the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey, ACS State & Local Solutions, Inc. entered into a monitoring protocol in March 1995 that requires periodic employee ethics training and quarterly certifications of compliance. The monitoring protocol was required by the New York TBTA as a condition of the award of the original New York E-ZPass contract in 1995. The other agencies participating in the New York E-ZPass program, the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey and the New York State Thruway Authority, decided to join in the protocol. We have repeatedly won recompetes for this project since the original award and continue to operate it today. While the monitoring protocol was not intended to be permanent when it was issued we have never asked for it to be terminated and continue to participate -see additional info

In the early 1990's, Lockheed Martin IMS (n.k.a. Conduent State & Local Solutions) was participating in a competitive procurement for a contract with the City of New York. There was an allegation that Lockheed Martin made an offer of employment to an employee of New York City supposedly in violation of the procurement rules. No determination or judgment against Lockheed Martin was made on this allegation. Later, once Lockheed Martin was awarded the New York E-ZPass contract, the MTA Board of Directors required the monitoring protocol as a condition of their approval of the award decision. Since then, this contract has been extended and re-awarded to Conduent several times for a total of about 25 consecutive years and counting. Conduent believes the monitoring program has been successful.

ACS State & Local Solutions, Inc. was the name of our legal entity at the time of contract award.
